

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


GOOD FOR THE GOOSE BOX

Lid & Base panels chart, p.69

There is an error in the chart for the lid panel. The stitching below the geese, beginning with the upper line of long-arm cross stitch and continuing to the half-Rhodes stitch at the lower point, has been incorrectly positioned one fabric thread further to the right than they should be.

See the corrected chart below.




There is an error in step 4 of the instructions for working Celtic Cross Stitch.
The correct sequence is shown below:

CELTIC CROSS STITCH


Also known as woven cross stitch, this can be used as a filling or as an ornate border.
The second cross can be worked in a different colour if desired.




1. Work a stitch from A to B and emerge at C.




2. Take the thread to the back at D and re-emerge at A.




3. Take the thread over the first cross and to the back at B. Re-emerge at D.



4. Take the needle under the lower and over the upper threads between A and B.



5. Take the needle to the back at C.



6. Pull the thread through. The threads should have a woven appearance at the centre of the cross.
